If you prefer not to walk around the Lost City, we offer a shorter scenic flight.

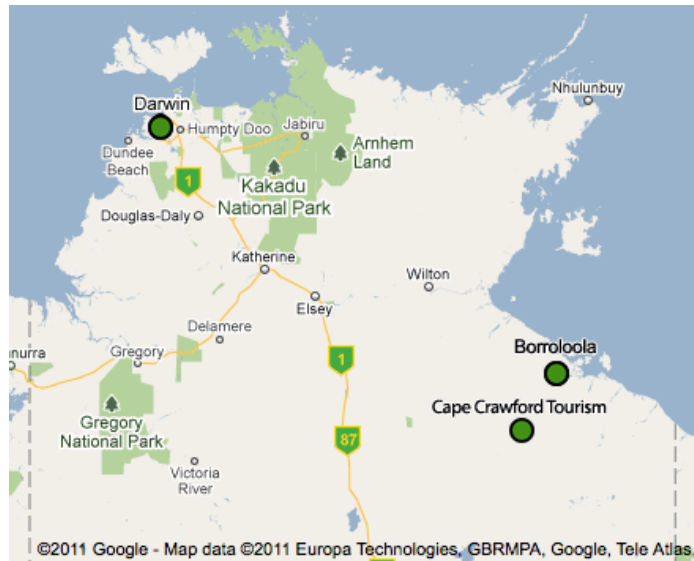
You'll fly over the fault line and along the escarpment giving you plenty of aerial photo opportunities.

During your spectacular flight around the Lost City your pilot will give you a detailed commentary of the region. A brief landing will enable you to take some stunning photographs of these magnificent towers from the ground.

Your return flight will capture the dramatic landscape of Cape Crawford named after Lindsay Crawford in 1882 while droving cattle to the Kimberleys.

The Lost City Scenic Flight leaves from a landing pad located opposite the Heartbreak Hotel.

### **The Lost City Ground Tour**

Helicopter is the only way in to the Lost City, and Cape Crawford Tourism is the only company with landing rights to take you there. Located on a plateau of the Abner Ranges, the Lost City's towering columns of sandstone, 1.4 billion years in the making, rise up to meet you as you land among them.

Circling a small section of the Lost City your experienced guide will take you on a casual stroll through these magical megaliths. The 1.5 km walk gives many great photo opportunities with the possibility of spotting the rare Carpentaria Grass Wren. Descriptions of the local Aboriginal culture, as well as the mining and pastoral history give an interesting narrative to the tour.

You will leave the region with a better knowledge of the local geology, flora & fauna.

The Lost City is truly a nature lover's paradise.

### **Poppy's Pools**

Indulge yourself in this eco-tourism treasure. These majestic pools are owned by Harry Lansen on Bauhina Downs. You will have exclusive rights to this thermal pool during your visit. Their source is from an aquifer located over 7 kilometers deep within the earth's crust. The water cools to 26 degrees celcius where you are spoilt with a beautiful waterfall. A cool spring flows to one side to cool you down after your therapeutic thermal spa.

View the Aboriginal artwork and visit the caves with Johnny Johnston or do a spot of fishing in Victoria Bay or in the estuaries.
